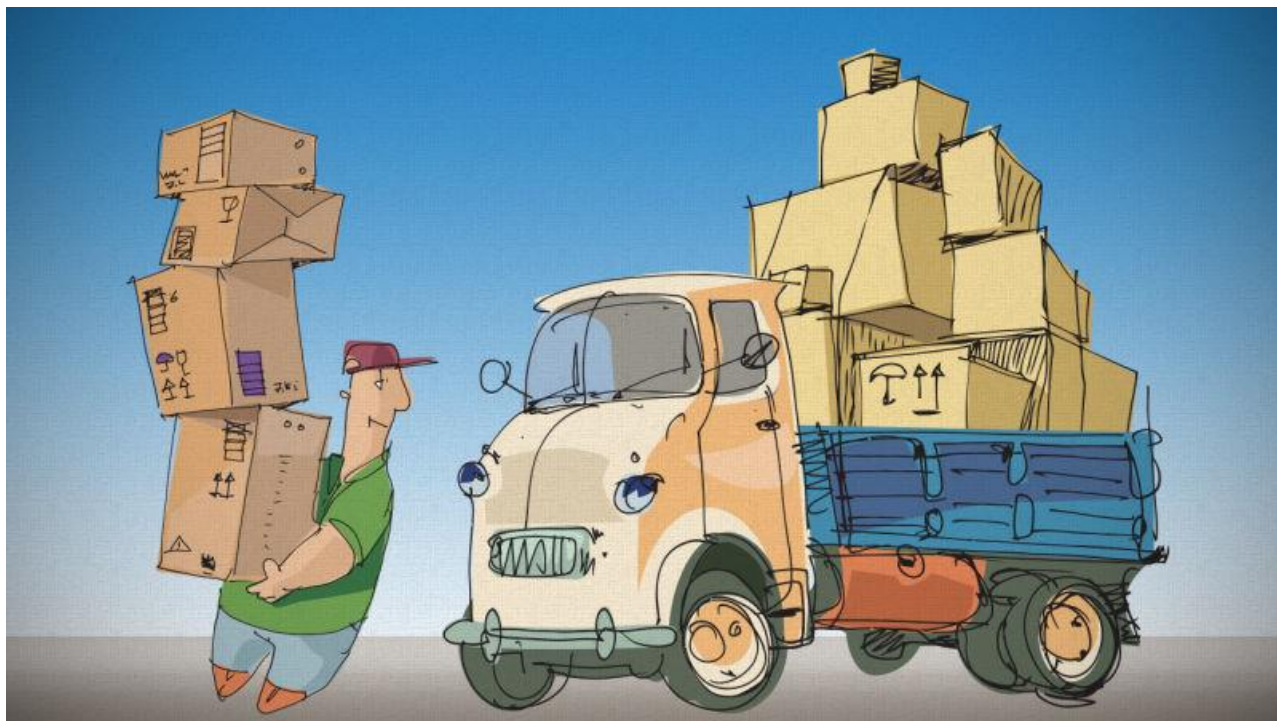

**MISSION:** Volunteer as mentors at the TAPS Good Grief Camp, for Gold Star children, supporting children of fallen military Apr. 1-2, 2017.

**MENTOR'S ROLE:** Each mentor is matched with a military child who lost his or her loved one. Children range from 4 to 18 years old; you may select the age group with which you prefer to work. You are placed in a group with other mentors and their mentees, led by an experienced and trained grief facilitator. Responsibilities include connecting with your mentee and following the lead of your group leader. Mentors must be available for training on Saturday morning, and participate in the camp all day Saturday and Sunday.
